## **Résumé Strategy**

Annie was seeking to become a nurse anesthetist after completing her Doctor of Nurse Anesthesia Practice. Although she had enjoyed a successful career in critical care and emergency medicine, she wanted to make this rather pronounced career change.

I asked her why she wanted to make this transition, but had already assumed she wanted a more peaceful job at a slower pace. Her answer, however, nearly brought me to tears.

Her critical care nursing career had been extremely fulfilling. Then one day, her daughter required an emergency appendectomy. Like most mothers watching their children going into surgery, Annie was extremely anxious. The anesthesiologist comforted her and it was in that moment that Annie realized her true calling. She wanted to be the one to comfort family members before their loved ones passed through the operating room doors.

Her story really inspired me as a differentiating feature within a résumé. Many nursing résumés are all about clinical hours and credentials, but few stories truly strike at the heart of what matters. Therefore I highlighted her personal story shortly after the introduction and added a matching image of operating doors to really drive the emotional point home.
